2018-2019 School Year Registration!

We have a few families that have not finished or started their children/s registration packet. Please take time this week to complete their enrollment. This is needed for us to move forward for our 18-19 school year budget, in purchasing books and supplies.

The process is the same as last year. You will need to login into your account at WWW.RENWEB.COM, parentsweb login. Click on **Family information** on left hand side of the page, then **enrollment/reenrollment**. Your enrolled students will appear and you will need to click **start enrollment packet for each student**. Once you have completed all the steps a green check mark will appear next to each completed step. If you receive a yellow triangle you are missing information in that section. The final step you are asked to **Review and Submit Enrollment Packet**, this step was periodically overlooked last year. This will direct you to pay the \$120 and complete your application. \$100 of this amount will be applied to your students Book and Technology fee for school year 2018-19. The Parent/Student Handbook and Fair Share Contract have changed and are available through the online enrollment. Please make sure you review the handbook and electronically sign.

You are asked to print the Fair Share Contract, fill it out and return to school May 4th, 2018.
