

Immaculate Conception School Dress Code

<u>Tops</u> (Boys and Girls)	
<p><u>Colors</u> (Must be solid) Blue (light, royal, navy) Pink White Gray</p>	<p><u>Style Choice - Short or Long Sleeved</u> Polo Shirt Collared Shirt Sweatshirt (To include the following styles: zip, crew or hooded. Students must wear a collared shirt underneath UNLESS they are wearing a hooded sweatshirt.) Sweaters (To include the following styles: vest or button down, with a collared shirt underneath.)</p>
<p>Shirts with ICS logo or <u>small</u> brand emblems or insignias are permitted. (E.g. “Columbia,” “A. E.”) These emblems or insignias must be located on the upper front - left or right. The administration reserves the right to make a determination on “what is or is not” appropriate with regards to small emblems or insignias that are not ICS logo.</p>	
<u>Bottoms</u> (Boys and Girls)	
<p><u>Colors</u> (Must be solid) Khaki Navy Gray Black</p>	<p><u>Style Choice</u> Shorts (must be finger tip length) Skirts (with built in shorts or leggings underneath) Jumpers (with built in shorts or leggings underneath) Capris Cargo Pants Chinos Knit Pants (Knit pants may be worn by grades PreK-5th ONLY. Knit pants must be non-clinging with boot cut or flair bottom. The administration reserves the right to make a determination on “what is or is not” appropriate with regards to knit pants.</p>

Cold weather wears “inside of school:” No prints or writing may appear on the solid colored outerwear when it is worn in the building. Small insignias are permitted as stated above.

Layer Clothing: If students choose to layer clothing (with long sleeve shirts or camisoles), only solid colored clothing may be worn and the colors must fall within the school’s dress code colors.

Mass Days: Students are to wear an ICS monogrammed polo shirt in navy or an ICS monogrammed sweatshirt/fleece in navy. It may be long or short sleeved. The monogrammed polo shirt or monogrammed sweatshirt is to be worn with khaki pants and/or skorts. Shirts may be purchased at MC Sport or Haase Embroidery in Monmouth.

Warm Weather Wear: Shorts may be worn August through October 15th and again from April 15th through the end of the school year. Length of shorts (and skirts) must fall below the middle finger when standing with arms to the side. No short shorts are permissible. The administration reserves the right to make a determination on “what is and what is not” appropriate with regards to the length of shorts and skirts.

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Additional Information: Elastic waists are acceptable. Belts are not required and students do not need to tuck tops. Sleeveless tops, sheer “see-thru” tops, and plunging necklines are not acceptable. Students must wear socks with their shoes.

Casual Fridays: Fridays are designated as “casual days.” On casual Fridays, students may wear clothing of choice. When the last day of school falls on a Thursday, students may dress casual. Parents are asked to review the Parent/Student Handbook. In all cases, the administration reserves the right to make a determination on “what is and what is not” appropriate.
