Safe Environment for Parent Volunteers

It's great to be able to have families come into the school and help with children's room parties, volunteering, and chaperoning field trips. Which means it is time to get your required forms completed for the dioceses. Please remember you will need to create an account <u>CMGConnect</u> to register, complete the "Safe Environment Training ", fill out a CANTS background check and criminal background check through <u>Selection</u>. There is a \$6 processing charge plus fees for each selection background check that each participant will be responsible for. These are all requirements by the Diocese to be involved with the children.

If you have already created an account please login to see if you are missing any required features or if any training features have expired. These things need to be completed before you can volunteer. If you are interested or have any questions please contact Mrs. Simmons at <u>fsimmons@immaculate-conception.net</u>. A volunteer folder with a requirement checklist and additional forms and information is available in the school office.

Medical requirements reminder

If you have a student that is new to our school. Please be reminded that we need a copy of the official county Birth Certificate and a current School Physical Examination. A dental exam is required for Kindergarten, 2nd

Grade & 6th Grade. Eye exams are required for Kindergarten before October 15th. Students entering Kindergarten or 6th grade are required to have a school physical by their family physician by <u>October 15th.</u>

Also, if your student needs an inhaler or takes a required medication prescribed from a doctor, we will need to have this information from their doctor. <u>Permission for Administration of Medication</u>
