## **Spalding Award Scholarship**

Tuition assistance scholarship grant from the endowment fund of the Diocese of Peoria ROOTED IN FAITH Campaign will be available for the 2021 - 2022 school year for students enrolled in or intending to enroll in grades Kindergarten – 8<sup>th</sup> grades. Families must be members of a Catholic parish in the diocese to apply.

All grants will be based on financial need objectively assessed. Information about the grants and application materials may be obtained from the school office or the Diocese of Peoria website [www.cdop.org](http://www.cdop.org) - click on EDUCATION; then OFFICE OF CATHOLIC SCHOOLS; then the Select list and click on SPALDING SCHOLARSHIPS. Consult the detailed Protocols and Procedures for all requirements necessary to be eligible for an award. Parents will need to also apply online at: [online.factsmgt.com/aid](http://online.factsmgt.com/aid).

Families of students currently receiving grants are reminded that all grants are for one year only, and anyone seeking to renew a grant for 2020 - 2021 must reapply. **Deadline date for the completed application is April 30, 2021.**  
Notification will be in June.
