Fair Share points have been updated and are available in your FACTS account under Incidental Expenses.

Each ICS family is responsible for earning \$300 in points per year. Not quite there yet?

Spalding Award Scholarship deadline extended to May 17th!

If you haven't applied for the Spalding Award Scholarship there is still time! The Tuition assistance scholarship grant from the endowment fund of the Diocese of Peoria ROOTED IN FAITH Campaign will be available for the 2021 - 2022 school year for students enrolled in or intending to enroll in grades Kindergarten – 8th grades.

Families must be members of a Catholic parish in the diocese to apply.

COVID reminders
